RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern all play except as modified by Local Rules as they appear on the "Notice to Competitors."

PRACTICE

On any day of a stroke play competition, practice is not allowed on the competition courses before or between rounds.

SCORING

- Exchange scorecards with other team.
- Cards marked at 95% of USGA Host Course Handicap.
- If partners have a difference of more than eight strokes, an additional 10% reduction will be applied to the player with the higher handicap.
- Please pick up when out of hole.

AWARDS

Two-day totals of better ball of partners determine winners.

Equal gross and net prizes awarded in each flight.

Approximately 1/3 of field will be paid.

Ties will be broken applying USGA back nine method, second day only.

One Closest-to-the-Hole award on Thursday only.

CLOTHING

No shorts or skirts shorter than 5 inches from middle of back of knee; no denim of any type; no tank or halter tops; no sweat suits; no leggings except under shorts; no clothing that exposes the midriff or stomach area (women's shirts must not rise above the beltline at any time during the golf swing); soft spikes only. No cell phones.

NOTE: No golf shoes allowed in Clubhouse except in Women's Locker Room and lower level at Lake Merced.

Contestants are responsible for their purses and personal belongings.

CANCELLATION AND "NO SHOW" POLICY

If a player cancels after **April 6**, no refund of entry fee (\$65.00) will be made. If a player cancels after **April 26**, it is a Late Cancellation, and she must pay for meal and cart fees (\$120.00) to avoid a late cancellation penalty of a one-year suspension from any WGANC tournament.

"NO SHOWS" at any WGANC Tournament will result in a two-year suspension from any WGANC Tournament to commence after payment of all meal and cart fees.
